

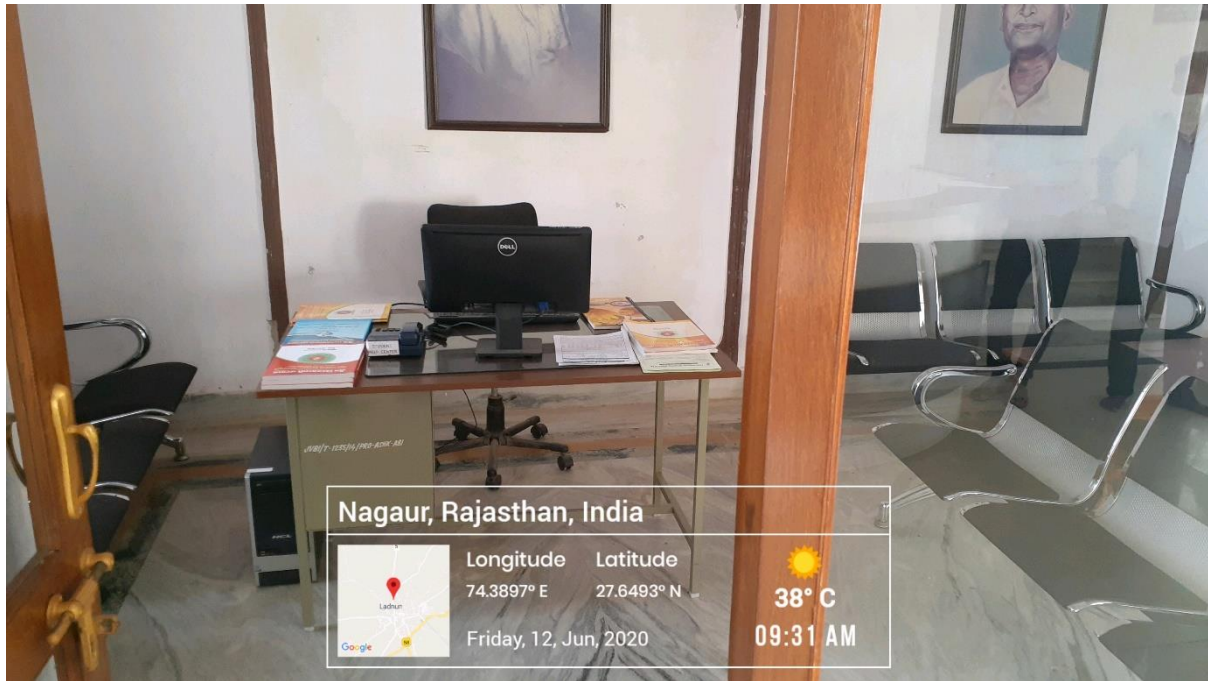

Different programme organised for gender sensitization

Extension Cell (Acharya Tulsi Shiksha Pariyojana) in supported by Akhil Bharatiya Terapanth Mahila Mandal, Jain Vishva Bharati started Acharya Tulsi Shiksha Pariyojna (ATSP) and Acharya Mahapragya Mahila Silai Prasikshan Kendra. These activities were implemented in nine centers in rural areas surrounding Ladnun. Out of these four are ATSP Centers and five are Silai Centers. Total students enrolled in 165. Out of this ATSP has 85 and Rest are in Silai Center.

The following activities were implemented in the year 2013-14:

1. Meeting of the teachers of this program organized on July 5, 2013 by the incharge of the Extension Directorate Dr. Pushpa Mishra and discussed about the prepration of action plan of the ongoing year, possible activities to be performed in the month of July, required resources of centres and increasing the enrollment of sudents in the center. Total seven teachers were present.
2. Organised Painting competition in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar and Sabjimandi and Magrabas Centres on 19th July.
3. On 7th August the directorate organized a singing competition in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar, Sabjimandi and Magrabas centres. The theme of the competition was patriotic songs. A total of 80 participants participated.
4. On 15th August, 2013 the directorate organized Independence Day on Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar, Sabjimandi and Magrabas centres. Flag ceremony ws also conducted in presence of incharge Extension cell at Dujar.
5. On 4th September organized mehandi Pratiyogita in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar, Sabjimandi and Magrabas centres. A total of 80 participants participated.
6. On 8th September the directorate organized rally on International Literacy Day in Ladnun City, Slums around Ladnun. The purpose was to create awareness about the education among people.
7. On 23rd September the directorate organized an Embroidery Competition in Harijan Basti, Dujar, Sabjimandi and Regar Basti centres. The theme of the competition was patriotic songs. A total of 40 participants participated.
8. On 4th October the directorate organized a General Knowledge competition in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar centres. The theme of the competition was related to knowledge about Rajasthan.
9. On 25th – 26th October the directorate organized a two day teachers training program in collaboration with department of education JVBI at Jain Vishva Bharati Institute.

10. On 5th November directorate organized a competition on Bouquet making in Harijan Basti and Dujar centres. A total of 10 participants participated. They used wooden sticks, cloths, Parag and wires to prepare their Bouquets.
11. The directorate organized a Rangoli Competition On 22nd November in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar, Sabjimandi and Magrabas centres. A total of 100 participants participated.
12. On 2nd December the directorate organized a rally on World Aids Day in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar. Red Ribbons that represent the spirit of unity against AIDS were given to people as a token of remembrance of this spirit of unity.
13. On 5th December the directorate organized a competition of Designer pillow cover making in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar and Regar Basti.
14. The directorate organized a competition programme on 13th December, 2013 on English Meaning and Antakshri. In this competition 20 participants each from Nimbi Jodha and Shariyabas, 35 from Harijan Basti and 18 from Dujar.
15. On 3rd January the directorate organized an Essay Competition on Jain Religion in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar.
16. On 8th January the directorate organized a competition on Decorative Dolls in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar.
17. On 26th January the directorate celebrated Republic Day in all the centres of ATSP. Flag ceremony was held in ATSP center at Shariyabas. In Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar the flags were hoisted by old women from respective areas. Cultural program related to patriotism was also held.
18. The directorate organized a General Knowledge competition On 5th March in Shariyabas, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti, Dujar centres. The theme of the competition was related to knowledge about Rajasthan. 19 participants were present.
19. On 12th March the directorate organized a Jhallar Making competition in Sabji Mandi, Regar Basti, Nimbi Jodha, Harijan Basti and Dujar centres. Redymade chains, coloured clothes, coloured wool and other decoration materials were used.
